MORE FUN AT THE PARK - UPDATE ON DEVELOPMENT

The Parish Council thanks residents who responded to the consultation about priorities for improving the Play Park in Wheatley Lane. The equipment asked for included: a replacement Zip Wire, an under '3s' 'Climb, Tunnel and Slide', new rockers and a hard surface for the basketball net. To pay for the equipment, the Council has a grant from 'Lost Village' and has applied to the National Lottery for the extra funds -'fingers crossed'. We should know the result by March. If we are successful, the equipment can be installed during 2026. The next part of the project is for climbing equipment for children over 8 years.

On Street and Pavement Parking

Now we are in winter and road conditions are not always of the best, residents are advised to park on the near side of the road in the built up area after dark so that red rear reflectors can be clearly seen. The alternative, particularly if an accident happens, may lead to a fine. Recurring incidents have been noticed of residents and visitors continuing to park on the footpaths within the village. This often forces pedestrians, especially the elderly and anyone with a pram or pushchair, onto the road. It is an offence to drive on a footpath and footpaths are also part of the highway. Apart from causing unnecessary danger to pedestrians, this behaviour may constitute an offence of obstructing the highway.

Sands Pond Area

Our Summer migrants having left for warmer climes, the volunteers have been busy cutting back overgrown areas near to the pond. This included strimming Back Lane to allow what will hopefully be a splendid show of snowdrops next Spring. The pond was at an all time low this year which permitted further removal of willow and also enabled the planting of reeds in the north-west corner. Also, ditches have been cleared which will allow eventual overflow from the pond to be drained away in an effective manner. Planters have been restocked with violas and Spring bulbs – we look forward to a good show next year! Bird boxes used mainly by robins and blue tits have been inspected /cleaned ready for next year.
