VE Day Commemoration - May 2025

The Parish Council has marked VE Day with the installation of a new commemorative seat on the Village Playing Field. A resident kindly donated the funds required to purchase the seat for the benefit of all residents who can now sit and enjoy the playing field facilities. A plaque will be fitted to mark the installation of this new seat. The Parish Council also supported the local commemoration event in the Village hall by waiving all hire charges.



SANDS POND AREA

If you have walked to the pond and surrounding area, you will have noticed the hard work the volunteers continue to do to maintain this area. A number of changes have been made over the year - more trees have been obtained from the Woodland Trust to add to those already planted in the community woodland in the field off Back Lane, planters have been introduced near the bench and the Parish Council has purchased equipment to ensure that the pond can be safely maintained in the future. Priorities for the coming year involve attempting to reduce the amount of bindweed on site and the installation of a duck raft.

Pond Dipping Evening

In early June, the Parish Council representatives Cllr. Jacques and Parish Clerk Debbie Parker welcomed Bassingham Brownies & Guides to a pond dipping evening at the Sands. This was the 3rd year the group has enjoyed a session exploring the nature at the pond area. The Brownies and Guides hold their weekly sessions in the Village Hall on Tuesdays from 6pm during term time.



North Kesteven District Council Commemorative Tree Planted

The Parish Council was successful in applying for a specimen tree from NKDC to mark their 50 years of being an authority. The tree was collected in March and planted on the playing field near the new seat.

Playing Field Development

During April, a new set of swings were installed on the Playing field with thanks to a grant from the Young People's Trust.

Thanks are extended to the Lost Village Festival who have awarded the Parish Council a grant of £2,500 towards a new cable way.

The Council thanks residents who took part in the recent consultation events about equipment at the playing field. As a result, the Council has decided to buy equipment suitable for independent play by children under 3 years. The main item chosen includes a scramble board, a tunnel and a slide. We also plan to replace a springer and, for older children, buy two 5 aside goals. Included in the 'package' will be the replacement of the popular Zip Wire and a base for the basketball hoop. The Council will be funding these items through grant applications, so 'fingers crossed'.

Grant funding often takes time, please be patient!

The Village Hall continues to welcome many regular groups who use the hall for their activities plus individual bookings for parties. Thanks to all who book our hall and for the great feedback which has led to bookings from the wider community. In January, after over 5 years cleaning in the hall, Sue North retired and we extend our thanks to her for her service during this time. In February, Agnieska Hook joined us in taking over the cleaning role. She ensures that the hall is kept clean and tidy for all bookings.

The Parish Council continues to carefully manage all running costs of the hall. Energy costs have been kept to a minimum with investment in solar panels, a battery for energy storage plus reviewing electricity contracts for the most favourable terms. May 2025 electricity invoice was only £2.53!!
